

Ukraine Sponsorship Scheme

This guide is for people looking to apply under the Ukraine Sponsorship Scheme (Homes for Ukraine)

You are eligible to apply for the Ukraine Sponsorship Scheme if:

1. You were living in Ukraine immediately before 1st January 2022, unless you are a child born after this date
2. You are a Ukrainian citizen or the immediate family member of a Ukrainian citizen who is applying with you under the scheme
3. You have a sponsor in the UK who is:
 - a. a British or Irish citizen; or
 - b. has settled status in the UK (also known as indefinite leave to remain)
4. You are outside the UK

Under the Ukraine Sponsorship Scheme, you will be granted 18 months leave to remain and will be able to work, study and access benefits. To find out more about the scheme and to apply, go to:

We have created this handy guide to help you complete the application form. The people in this application form are fictional. The information in this form is correct as of 21st February 2024.

You will first need to provide a country where you will be able to provide your biometrics. Please note that this cannot be Ukraine as there are no biometric centres open there. This should be the country you are currently in.

Select a country to provide your biometrics

To complete your application, you must provide your biometrics (fingerprints and facial photograph). This may involve attending a visa application centre (VAC) operated by one of our commercial partners.

We need to know which commercial partner will manage your biometrics appointment. This is so we can transfer you to the correct website after you have submitted your visa application.


Enter the country where you would like to provide your biometrics. This will usually be the country you are in now. If there is no VAC in your selected country, you will be able to choose an alternative location.

If you believe you are unable to provide your biometrics at any location, you should still choose a location. You will then be told how to proceed.
